

## A Few Words from the Pastor:

**Annual Wedding Anniversary Liturgy** - The deadline for registering to attend the Annual Diocesan Wedding Anniversary Liturgy is Tuesday, August 22. If you are celebrating a wedding anniversary of 1, 5, 10, 25, 40, 50, 55, and 60+ years in 2017, you are invited to attend along with your family. Couples may choose to attend the Sunday, September 10, 2:00 mass at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in Altoona or the Sunday, September 17, 2:00 mass in Johnstown at St. John Gualbert Cathedral. Bishop Mark will be the celebrant and homilist at both liturgies. Call the parish office (942-5503) to register.

**Communion at Age 7** - it is common practice that children in the Roman Catholic Church receive their first Holy Communion at the age of seven, the age of reason. It has not always been this way. Our grandparents and great grandparents would have waited until they were 12 to make their first Holy Communion. It was St. Pius X, whose feast we celebrate on Monday, who lowered the age of communion to the age of reason. He did this with an encyclical issued in August of 1910. His motto was "to restore all things in Christ." Making communion more available to the young, as well as encouraging frequent communion, was one step that he took in renewing the church in Christ.

**Come Pray Morning Prayer With Us** - it has long been the practice here at St. John's to pray morning prayer together prior to the celebration of the Eucharist. We do so in union with the church throughout the world, as we welcome a new day in service of the Lord. Please join us at 8:10 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, when we pray the Psalms together.

**Honoring Mary** – On the octave of the Assumption, Tuesday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>, the church celebrates the Queenship of Mary. Having been assumed into heaven, she is crowned queen of heaven and earth! These two events in Mary's life are the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Glorious Mysteries! On Thursday, we celebrate the feast of the Apostle Bartholomew. The parish in Wilmore, one of the oldest in the diocese, bears his name.

**Penn State Altoona Mass** – In September Mass for the college students will resume, held in Eve Chapel each Sunday evening at 7:00. Should you miss Mass here, you are always welcome with the students!

**Scholarship Available** - The John and Helen Despot Scholarship Fund is making available a \$450 Scholarship for any child of St. John's who is attending a Catholic elementary school in this coming school year. Applications are available in the Gathering Space or can be obtained from the parish office. The deadline for application is Labor Day, and the scholarship will be awarded later in the month. We are grateful for generosity of the Despot family, who has so generously established this fund in memory of their parents John and Helen.

**A \$20,000 Matching Grant** - We are most grateful to all who have already contributed toward our matching grant! We have extended the deadline until Labor Day. 
