**Moments of Mercy** – The Feast of the Immaculate Conception marked the opening of the Jubilee Year of Mercy. Throughout this year, each week there will be special "Moment of Mercy" on the front of our bulletin. You are encouraged to prayerfully read this "moment" and consider the place of Mercy in your daily life.

**Family Life Calendars for 2015** - We are blessed to have such an active Family Life Office in our diocese, which has for many years made available a beautiful calendar. These are available now in the Gathering Space.

**Our Next Bus Trip: The Pennsylvania Farm Show** – We've all seen it on TV, but there is nothing like an actual visit to the PA Farm Show! Mark your calendars for **Thursday, January 14.** Pennsylvania hosts the largest indoor agricultural exposition in the nation, with nearly 6,000 animals, 10,000 competitive exhibits and 300 commercial exhibits. This will be the 100<sup>th</sup> annual Farm Show! There is no cost for admission, with an amazing food court to satisfy all your culinary desires! The cost for transportation is only \$40 for adults, and our school children will travel free. Sign up now in the Gathering Space!
