

A Few Words from the Pastor:

Special Collection for Nepal – The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has asked that every parish take a second collection for the suffering people of Nepal, where a devastating earthquake has taken the lives of thousands and has left tens of thousands homeless. We will take up that collection next Sunday, May 17th. Please be generous!

Ascension Thursday: A Holy Day of Obligation – Thursday the Church Universal celebrates the Ascension of the Lord. Our Vigil Mass will be celebrated at 6:00PM on Wednesday evening, and Masses of the Ascension Thursday will be offered at 8:30AM and 6:30PM. All are urged to make a special effort to participate in this Solemn Feast.

Heartfelt Thanks – I am so very much appreciative of the generosity of so many in their help in preparing for the celebration of my ordination anniversary. My God be praised for the gift of priestly ministry, and we pray that God will inspire more young men to follow the call to service of Christ in the priesthood. As Jesus reminds us, "the harvest is great, but the laborers are few." Please pray for vocations!

May, the Month of Mary – May is traditionally the month of Mary, when Catholics are invited to venerate the Mother of God. Families are encouraged to pray the Rosary together, and even to prepare a special "May Altar" in the home, where a statue of Mary can be honored with fresh spring flowers.
