

## A Few Words from the Pastor:

**Share the Journey** - On September 27, 2017, Pope Francis launched a global campaign to support immigrants and refugees around the world called "Share the Journey." Our brothers and sisters often make perilous journeys, leaving their homelands because they are forced to flee their homes to escape conflict, poverty, persecution and violence. There are more refugees and internally displaced people now— over 65 million—than at any other time in recorded history. Our faith calls us to "love our neighbor," to see Christ in those who are in greatest need, and to welcome newcomers seeking the security, peace, and opportunity they cannot find in their home. **This weekend** we celebrate the blessings that have come to our nation through immigrants from around the world. We are urged to see each immigrant as an image of Christ in need.

**Our Prayer for the Week** – All are encouraged to pray the Prayer for the Global Migration Campaign on the enclosed flyer daily for the millions of our brothers and sisters who are migrants and refugees.

**Adult Ed - Untold Blessings!** – We continue with Bishop Barron's program on Three Paths of Holiness. The second path is "Knowing You Are a Sinner." **Join us after the 8:00 Mass in the Cafeteria!**

**To Walk in Jesus' Footsteps** – Our pilgrimage to the Holy Land has taken shape. The dates are May 16 to May 26, 2018. The trip includes all round-trip travel costs from Altoona to Tel Aviv. We will be spending three nights in Nazareth and five nights in Jerusalem. In Israel we will travel in a private, air-conditioned bus, with an English speaking guide for all nine days. Most meals are included. Most importantly, we will be celebrating Mass daily in the holiest sites in Christendom. Total cost for double occupancy is \$3,850. An informational meeting will take place on Monday, October 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00PM in the cafeteria.

**SECOND SUNDAY FOOD COLLECTION** this weekend is for the benefit of St. Vincent DePaul Assumption Chapel food pantry. For the remainder of this year, we will not use our food collection for our Angel Tree program. However, we have 2 new food pantries to add to our outreach. For the second Sunday, November 11-12, we will donate our food & funds to the Penn State U. Altoona Campus Ministry food pantry, and for the collection December 9-10 will give to the St. Luke's Episcopal Church food pantry. We will post suggested items for the PSU food pantry to accommodate needy students who typically don't have access to a kitchen.

**HURRICANE MARIA COLLECTION:** As residents of Puerto Rico deal with the aftermath of Hurricane Maria and residents of Central Mexico recover from a devastating earthquake, Bishop Mark is once again calling on the faithful of Altoona-Johnstown to offer prayerful and financial support to the victims. In a letter to clergy on September 28, the Bishop asked that all parishes in the Diocese take up a special collection for disaster relief as soon as possible. Our second collection will be NEXT weekend, October 14 &15. All money collected will go to Catholic Charities USA, which is already assisting in the affected areas. "I urge everyone to be as generous as possible," Bishop Bartchak said. "I extend my thanks to all for their prayers and financial assistance in this time of need."






