

Of Feasts and Saints – On Thursday we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, followed on Friday by the feast of our Mother of Sorrows. These celebrations go side by side for good reason, for certainly it was at the foot of the Cross that Mary was overcome with sorrow! Book-ending these feasts are the commemoration of St. John Chrysostom on Wednesday, and the martyrs Cornelius and Cyprian on Saturday. St. John Chrysostom lived in the 4th century and is considered one of the great preachers of Christian history. He served as Bishop of Constantinople before being exiled by his adversaries, and died in exile in 407 AD. Cornelius and Cyprian were lasting friends, and are always remembered together. Serving the church in the 3rd century, both were martyred for their faith – Cornelius as Pope, and Cyprian as bishop of Carthage. Of Cyprian St. Jerome wrote: "It is superfluous to speak of his greatness, for his works are more luminous than the sun."

Our Catholic Ministries Drive – We are most appreciative of your support of our Catholic Ministries Drive. Caring for the Poor and Strengthening Families, Nurturing our Youth, and Forming Clergy and Laity, are the needs which your contributions sustain. Our parish goal is \$45,713, toward which we have received \$35,735. Please be generous.

Pilgrimages - I have begun making plans with Mr. Jim Roccio for a pilgrimage to the Holy Land in May of 2018. If you recall, Jim is the planner for our Ireland and Rome trips in the past. We will be giving more info in the near future. Looking ahead, in 2019 we would like to plan a summer trip to the California Missions (San Diego, Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, San Francisco, and the wine country). In 2020, we will be planning a pilgrimage to Oberammergau in Bavaria, Germany, to experience the world-renowned Passion Play, which is presented only every ten years.


