A Few Words from the Pastor:

Training for Eucharistic Ministers – On Sunday, October 4th, at 5:00PM, there will be a special training session in the church for anyone who would like to serve the parish as a Eucharistic Minister. Please give serious consideration to this invitation to take a more active role at Mass.

Nocturnal Adoration at St. John's – This Friday evening, from 8 until 11, there will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Day Chapel. Nocturnal Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a devotion practiced on the evening before the First Friday of the Month, and parishioners from around the city will be joining us. Please plan on joining us. As Jesus reminded his disciples in Gethsemani, "Could you not watch with me for one hour?"

Holy Relics - During the World Meeting on the Family this week, there was on display the Martin family reliquary, which contains relics of St. Therese of Lisieux and of her parents, Blessed Louis and Zelie Martin, at the Cathedral Basilica of Sts. Peter and Paul in Philadelphia. This holy couple, whose "Little Flower" Therese was canonized a saint and doctor of the Church, will be the first married couple ever canonized in the Catholic Church. We remember them especially this *Thurs*day, October 1st, when the church celebrates the memory of their daughter, the "Little Flower." This remarkable couple were parents of nine children, though four of them died at a very early age. Louis and Zelie remained steadfast in their faith, and poured out their love on the remaining five children, Pauline, Leonie, Celine, and their youngest, Marie-Francoise-Therese Martin. All five daughters would enter the Carmelite convent. The beauty and spirituality of this family is expressed so well in the countless letters which have survived, as well as the classic Story of a Soul by the Little Flower.

Not To be Overshadowed are the other feasts celebrated this week: The archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are honored on Tuesday, the life of the great Scripture scholar Saint Jerome is celebrated on Wednesday, and our beloved Guardian Angels are remembered on Friday, October 2. So many reasons to make an effort to get to daily Mass this week!
