1. Prayer & Opening

d) Various Items from Previous Meetings

Monsignor will be exploring the idea of having tee shirts / hats/ bracelets made for the event.

a) Parish Pastoral Plan

After last month's discussion on the 5 models of the church, we thought that it would be appropriate to review the parish mission statement to be sure that it aligns with the new insights gained through our previous discussions.
