

A Few Words from the Pastor:

From Genesis To Jesus – I am most grateful to Deacon Gene for conducting our Adult Faith Formation program this fall. We will be using an excellent series which gives an in-depth look at the Covenant which God has made with his people, in both the Old and New Testament. I intend myself to give greater attention to our young people in their Faith Formation. The young are our future and face many challenges living their Christian faith. I will be walking with them!

Season of Creation: Prayer AND Action! – Prayer must be accompanied by action!

During this Season of Creation, September 1 through October 4, all are encouraged to consider their relationship to the world around them, and how each of us can take greater care of our earth, our “Common Home.” Certainly recycling is something that all of us can do. Another suggestion is that we limit our use of “one use” plastic bags from the grocery store. We will be providing reusable bags in the hope that we limit the oceans of plastic that are placed in our landfills and oceans. We are also planning some activities for our young people, developing in them a greater awareness of our need to be good stewards of the earth! Over the next few weeks I will be writing more about this Season of Creation, in preparation for an interfaith/ecumenical prayer service to be held here at St. John’s on Sunday, September 8th, at 6:00 PM.



Religious Formation to Begin – We are looking forward to another inspiring year for our children! We are beginning registration now, and expect that our first class will be held on September 8. At this session all children and parents are to attend. I will be giving my undivided attention to our children throughout this year, as we seek to form young disciples of the Lord Jesus.

Forming Worshiping Catholics - Long after our young receive the sacrament of Confirmation and complete their formal instructions in the faith, what endures is a love for and participation in the Mass. The Lord’s Day is an essential part of their faith throughout their lives. Thus, as we focus on faith formation with our young people during this coming year, we will make “participation in the liturgy” an essential part of their formation. They will be invited and trained to join the choir, serve at Mass, participate as lectors, assist in the ministry of hospitality, and be part of our Sunday offertory procession. To grow in love for the Mass will keep them worshiping on the Lord’s Day, not only during their youth, but throughout their lives.

Creation Corner – Our popes have had much to say to us about our care for the environment. Each Sunday during the Season of Creation, and monthly thereafter, there will be a short reading highlighting the concern of the church for the care of our common home. Here is an example:

When we talk about the environment, about creation, my thoughts turn to the first pages of the Bible, the Book of Genesis, which states that God placed man and woman on earth to cultivate and care for it. And the question comes to my mind: What does cultivating and caring for the earth mean? Are we truly cultivating and caring for creation? Or are we exploiting and neglecting it? Pope Francis


