b) Survey Results

In order to get a detailed picture of where we would like to place our efforts in the coming years, we completed survey to collect the thoughts of the parishioners that we represent. The three most popular responses of each question are listed (i.e., the percentages may not add up to 100% as not all answers are represented here):

- What attracted you to be a member Saint John's parish?
 - 31% Church community
 - 28% Closeness to home
 - 20% Music ministry
- What is Saint John's greatest strength?
 - 36% Warm and welcoming
 - 24% Music ministry
 - 15% Relevant, thought out homilies
- What is Saint John's greatest weakness?
 - 34% Outreach to younger families
 - 23% Youth programming
 - 14% Lack of intergenerational activities
- What can Saint John's do to be more open in the community?
 - 39% Saint John's does an admirable job in the community
 - 30% Family gatherings for any occasion
 - 20% Weekly / monthly activities for the elderly
