## A Few Words from the Pastor:

**SPECIAL COLLECTIONS FOR OUR RETIRED PRIESTS** – We are blessed to have the priests' retirement home so close by to our parish, as they are able to assist us here in the parish. A special collection will be taken up next weekend for their support. An envelope is in your packet. Please be generous!

**CELEBRATING PADRE PIO** – On Monday we observe the memorial of Saint Padre Pio, a Capuchin Friar of the 20th century who is renowned for his holiness of life. There are many miracles attributed to Padre Pio: miracles of healing, of conversion, of bilocation, and the stigmata (bearing the wounds of Christ in his body). His miracles brought many people to Christ and illuminated God's goodness and love for us. We are most grateful in this diocese that the Capuchin Friars are now staffing our parish and retreat center in New Baltimore, bringing the spirit of Padre Pio with them!

**HURRICANE DORIAN** – Our hearts break when we see the devastation done to the Bahamas by hurricane Dorian. A Special collection has been announced in parishes around the country to assist with their recovery. Special envelopes will be distributed this weekend and next. Please be generous!

**NEW SIDEWALK** – You will notice a new sidewalk coming from the gravel parking lot to the front of the church. We are most grateful to Dave Auerbeck and his crew for the fine workmanship!

**OUR RECENTLY CONFIRMED!** – Over the next few weeks I will be meeting with the young people of our parish who received the Sacrament of Confirmation this past April. We will be discussing ways that they can respond to the grace of this sacrament by fuller participation in the life of our parish family!

**BEING GOOD STEWARDS OF THE EARTH!** Pope Francis wrote recently, "Our Earth needs constant concern and attention. Each of us has a personal responsibility to care for creation, this precious gift which God has entrusted to us. This means, on the one hand, that nature is at our disposal, to enjoy and use properly. Yet it also means that we are not its masters. Stewards, but not masters. We need to love and respect nature, but instead we are often guided by the pride of dominating, possessing, manipulating, exploiting; we do not 'preserve' the Earth, we do not respect it, we do not consider it as a freely given gift to look after. Respect for the environment, however, means more than not destroying it; it also means using it for good purposes."

**BE A GREEN BELIEVER!** - We can each do our part in eliminating one-use plastic bags by using our own grocery bags. We are providing bags to assist with your grocery shopping, with the reminder that we are doing what we can to care for our environment.

**A LETTER TO THE SUFFERING CHURCH** - Bishop Robert Baron has written a wonderful booklet on the sexual abuse crisis. We are making these books available to our parishioners at no cost. I will be leading a study of this book each Wednesday evening at 7 o'clock, until October 2. All are most welcome to attend one or all of the sessions.

**CATHOLIC MINISTRIES DRIVE** – To date we have received more than half (30K) of our parish goal of 43K for the Catholic Ministry Drive. An interesting statistic is that less than 50 households have responded to this appeal out of 501. That amounts to approximately 10% of our parish households. Among the many ministries sustained by this drive is Catholic Charities, campus ministry, and our Fulton County mission. Your sacrifices are greatly appreciated.

**FROM GENESIS TO JESUS** – This program of study of the bible has begun and will continue until Thanksgiving. Enrich your faith life! Join us on Sunday mornings between the Masses in the cafeteria.

**TWO SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE!** The John and Helen Despot Scholarship Fund is making available two \$450 Scholarship for any child of St. John's who is attending a Catholic elementary or middle school in this coming school year. **How does Educating Youth give help, build hope, and change lives?**


**Give Help-** Religious education teaches youth the importance of helping others and how to follow Jesus and spread his word out into the world.


