



## A Few Words from the Pastor:

**MISSION APPEAL, OCTOBER 20** – This weekend we welcome Father Paschal Agor, a missionary priest from Nigeria. A visit from a missionary is always an occasion to broaden our vision of the Catholic Church and our global mission to preach the gospel. Your generosity to this mission appeal will assist our missionaries in serving Christ in foreign lands!

**FALL CLERGY CONFERENCE** – Your prayers are asked for the clergy of the diocese, as we gather at the Antiochian Village Retreat Center for our annual conference. The focus this year will be on the Eucharist, the source and summit of the Christian life. The conference begins on Monday afternoon and concludes on Wednesday afternoon.

**OUR ARTIST IN RESIDENCE** – Allen Capriotti was honored at the Mishler on Thursday evening, being inducted into Blair County Arts Foundation Hall of Fame. The contribution which Allen has made to our worship space cannot be overestimated. For the past five years he has been painting the gospel of St. John the Evangelist, surrounding the church with scenes from the life of Jesus. Kudos to Allen, for a reward well-deserved!

**SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD** - In an apostolic letter released September 30, Pope Francis has declared that the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time will be devoted to the celebration and study of the Word of God. The document is called *Aperuit illis*, from its opening words in Latin, taken from St. Luke's Gospel, where the Evangelist describes how the Risen Jesus appeared to His disciples, and how "He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures." Recalling the importance given by the Second Vatican Council to rediscovering Sacred Scripture for the life of the Church, Pope Francis says he wrote this Apostolic Letter in response to requests from the faithful around the world to celebrate a Sunday of the Word of God. With this apostolic letter, the pope "invites us to hold the word of God in our hands every day as much as possible so that it becomes our prayer, and a greater part of our lived experience." In 2020 this special Sunday will be January 26.

**WORLD MISSION SUNDAY:** Today is World Mission Sunday. We celebrate this day by remembering our baptismal call - to bring the Gospel to all! The collection today for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith ensures the work and service of the Mission Church, as it supports priests, religious and lay leaders who offer the Lord's mercy and concrete help to the most vulnerable communities in the Pope's missions.

Thank you for your generosity.

**DAILY MASS AND FUNERALS** – Because of the close proximity of a morning funeral to the 8:30 AM Mass, going forward our 8:30 daily Mass will be cancelled on days when we have a funeral. Those daily Mass attendees are encouraged to represent the parish at the funeral. Thank you for understanding!

**SYNOD FOR AMAZONIA** – This month over 200 people are gathered in the Vatican for a synod to discuss the life and ministry of the Church in the Pan-Amazonian region of South America, an area surrounding the Amazon River which spans nine countries and is the size of Australia. Entitled *Amazonia: New Pathways for the Church and for an Integral Ecology*, this synod is the initiative of Pope Francis, and was announced in 2017. The two years since then have been spent planning for this month's gathering. According to the head of the Synod of Bishops, Cardinal Lorenzo Baldisseri, around 260 events were held in the Amazon to prepare for the synod. Most of those events were listening and consultation sessions, attended by approximately 87,000 people. Clearly Pope Francis wishes to show that our Church is a "listening Church," desiring to hear the voices of the people on the margins.

The principal objective indicated by the pope for the synod is that of "finding new ways for evangelization for that portion of the people of God, in particular the indigenous persons, often forgotten and without the prospect of a serene future. It is meant also to attend to the crisis of the Amazon forest, a lung of fundamental importance for our planet." We pray for an abundance of grace upon this important gathering!


