As was reported in last Monday's edition of the Altoona Mirror, the SNAP program, (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), is being cut, so that families in need will receive significantly less assistance. This will affect not only families, but senior citizens. Your generosity to our Second Sunday Food collection is so very important. Cash donations can be placed in the collection at any time and are always deeply appreciated.

PENANCE SERVICE - Our Lenten Penance Service is next Sunday, March 19, at 4:00 PM. This is a great opportunity to make your Lenten confession and to receive the Lord's forgiveness as you prepare for Easter. SAINT PATRICK'S DAY - Bishop Mark Bartchak has granted a dispensation from the obligation of Catholics in the diocese to abstain from meat on Friday, March 17, 2023, the Feast of Saint Patrick. Any Catholic in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown who chooses to accept this dispensation should perform some other act of penance in its place. Catholics who choose to observe the traditional Lenten abstinence from meat on that day are not required to perform any other penitential acts.
