A Few Words from the Pastor:

WEEK 11 OF OUR SACRED STORY RETREAT: My quiet prayer time this week is given over to writing a letter to Christ Jesus, asking for his help and healing for my story. This letter is my confession of faith in Him who comes to heal me and forgive me. This is my opportunity to tell Christ where I have been wounded by sin and life's difficulties, how I struggle for wholeness, and why I need the help of Jesus and his forgiveness. I will ask Jesus this week to be my Savior. He comes at Christmas to enfold me with his merciful healing!

THE ADVENT PRACTICE OF THE JESSE TREE: The Tree of Jesse is a depiction in art of the ancestors of Jesus Christ, shown in a branching tree which rises from Jesse of Bethlehem, the father of King David. It is the original use of the family tree, as a schematic representation of a genealogy. A new ornament is added to the Jesse tree each day, accompanied by a reading related to the corresponding symbol from the Old Testament. This practice helps Christians connect with the history of salvation and prepare their hearts for the celebration of Christmas.

JESSE TREE PRAYER

Lord God,
Our hearts long for your coming.
We wait to joyfully welcome you.
Father in Heaven,
soon the glory of your son, Jesus
will make the night bright with light.
Prepare our hearts and minds for the coming of your Beloved Son.

OPLATKI -This Christmas wafer is a popular, family-centered Christmas tradition enjoyed by families from Eastern Europe. The Oplatki tradition originated in Poland and is traced to the early centuries of Christianity. This Christmas custom began with a simple white wafer baked from flour and water. The word means "Angel Bread," and the wafer is shared before the Christmas Eve dinner. These wafers are available in the Gathering Space.

THE "O ANTIPHONS" are the scriptural images that give depth to our Advent prayer as we approach the birth of the Messiah. We pray them from December 17-23. They are a magnificent theology that uses ancient biblical imagery drawn from the messianic hopes of the **Old Testament** to proclaim the coming Christ as the fulfillment not only of **Old Testament** hopes, but present ones as well. Their repeated use of the imperative "Come!" embodies the longing of all for the Divine Messiah. The titles for the Messiah are:

- O Wisdom of our God Most High,
- O Leader of the House of Israel,
- O Root of Jesse's stem,
- O Key of David,
- O Radiant Dawn,
- O King of all nations and keystone of the Church:
- O Come, O Come, Emmanuel.

STEWARDSHIP CORNER: Today we celebrate the Third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday. 'Gaudete' is a Latin word meaning 'rejoice'. The Christian steward should be characterized by a spirit of rejoicing. The more we embrace the stewardship way of life, the more we will be filled with joy. We can become like John the Baptist, in today's Gospel passage from the Book of John.
