# A Few Words from the Pastor:

**WEEK 9 OF OUR SACRED STORY RETREAT:** Our retreat is based upon the trust we have in the Grace of Christ, given for our conversion of life. This week we are to ask for the grace to remember God's special blessings, to enrich our relationships with our significant others, to deepen in our spiritual life of prayer and penance, to have a positive impact on our parish community, to experience financial security so that we might be more generous with others, and to forgive that person whom we've had the most difficulty forgiving. This is a lot for one week, but it is the opening up of our life for a deeper relationship with Christ. The words of St. Ambrose given below, can inspire us!!!

**ADVENT PENANCE SERVICE** – An important part of every retreat is the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. A personal confession to a priest requires humility and honesty. We cannot grow spiritually without this sacrament, for it invites us to encounter our sinfulness and to experience the healing of Christ, our Divine Physician. Our parish communal Penance Service will be celebrated this Sunday, December 3rd, at 4:00 PM. Please join us.

**THE SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, DECEMBER 8TH** - please note that the Immaculate Conception, patronal feast of the United States, is a holy day of obligation. Our Vigil Mass will be celebrated on Thursday evening at 6:00PM and Masses on the feast day itself will be celebrated at 8:30 AM and 6:00 PM. Please join us!

**EUROPEAN PILGRIMAGE – June 3 – 16, 2024:** I will be leading pilgrimage to some of the most sacred sites in Europe. We will be travelling first to Rome, and then on to Lisbon, Fatima, Lourdes and Paris. There are still a few seats available, and I would welcome the pleasure of your company! **AN IMPORTANT COLLECTION COMING UP!** The annual collection that supports nearly 25,000 elderly religious sisters, brothers and religious order priests in the United States will take place in participating dioceses next weekend. The collection, coordinated by the National Religious Retirement Office (NRRO), distributes financial assistance for retirement needs to eligible religious institutes. Be generous when the time comes!

**THIS WEEKS SACRED STORY:** SAINT AMBROSE, whose feast we celebrate on December 7th, was born around 340 AD to a Roman Christian family, and is one of the four original doctors of the Church. While Bishop of Milan, he brought into the Christian Faith Saint Augustine, the wayward son of Saint Monica. Because of the great influence which Ambrose had upon Augustine, Monica loved Ambrose "as an angel of God who uprooted her son from his former ways and led him to his convictions of Christ." Ambrose is noted for his spiritual wisdom::

"Let your door stand open to receive Christ, unlock your soul to Him, offer Him a welcome in your mind, and then you will see the riches of simplicity, the treasures of peace, the joy of grace. Throw wide the gate of your heart, stand before the sun of the everlasting light..."

"No one heals himself by wounding another."
