A Few Words from the Pastor:

<u>WEEK 20</u> OF OUR SACRED STORY RETREAT: We have now begun to reflect on the Five Step Structure of Daily Sacred Story Prayer: CREATION, PRESENCE, MEMORY, MERCY, ETERNITY. The fourth of these meditations is MERCY. In our Daily Examen, after reflecting upon all of life as God's gift, that He is fully present to us and us to Him, and having reviewed our day and noticed our failure to love as Christ has loved, we now beg our God's mercy. "I believe that forgiveness is the only path to healing and illumination. I beg for the grace of forgiveness and the grace to forgive, especially for the sins and failures of this day, and from my past life. I will seek Christ's healing in the Sacrament of Reconciliation."

A LENTEN CONFESSION - An essential element of Lenten living is the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Its importance in our spiritual life cannot be stressed enough. Next Sunday, March 3rd, at 4 PM, we will be celebrating our Lenten Penance Service, when several priests will be present to assist with individual confessions. We come before God and acknowledge our sinfulness in thought, word, and deed!

A PARISH BIBLE STUDY ON THE GOSPEL OF MARK. We meet at 6:45 on Wednesday evenings in the parish center. Bring your favorite bible and prepare to embark on an inspiring Lenten Journey.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS - To encourage greater participation for Stations, and to promote a greater love for the Holy Eucharist, our Friday evening devotions will begin at 5:00 with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, with Stations of the Cross beginning at 5:30. Stations will conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Please consider joining us!

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE: Remember that the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence from meat. Throughout the season of Lent, however, DAILY FASTING can strengthen our will, remind us of the hungers of the human family, and certainly can put us in mind of our hunger for God. Our fasting is closely related to our care for the poor: when I fast, another person must eat in my place!

SPIRITUAL READING - An essential part of the Christian life is prayerful reflection. This is especially so within the season of Lent. We will again be making available a booklet of daily meditations for use throughout the Lenten Season. Consider this Lent to be a personal retreat!

TO BE CLEAR! - The church has continued to affirm that marriage is the union of a man and a woman. It's perennial teaching on marriage is unchanged. Such unions are blessed in the holy sacrament of matrimony. The recent approval of a blessing for same-sex couple is not to be understood as an approval of a "marriage." Should such a couple approach a priest for a blessing, the following may be offered: "Lord, look at these children of yours, grant them health, work, peace, and mutual help. Free them from everything that contradicts your gospel and allow them to live according to your will. Amen."

It is important to remember that God blesses us not because **WE** are good, but because **HE** is good!
