A Few Words from the Pastor:

WEEK 21 OF OUR SACRED STORY RETREAT: We have been reflecting on the Five Step Structure of Daily Sacred Story Prayer: CREATION, PRESENCE, MEMORY, MERCY, ETERNITY. The fifth of these meditations is ETERNITY. This step in our daily examen invites us to look "forward" with great confidence to a future which is brimming with grace. Having reflected upon my need for God, my brokenness, and my need for healing, I believe now the grace of forgiveness will open my heart. It will make my every thought word and deed bear fruit that endures to eternity. In this step I desire to be graced with the profound consciousness of the healing love of Christ Jesus. Going forward, everything in my life is to serve the great work of Christ for Universal Reconciliation and Peace.

A LENTEN CONFESSION - An essential element of Lenten living is the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Its importance in our spiritual life cannot be stressed enough. This Sunday, March 3rd, at 4 PM, we will be celebrating our Lenten Penance Service, when several priests will be present to assist with individual confessions. We come before God and acknowledge our sinfulness in thought, word, and deed!

A PARISH BIBLE STUDY ON THE GOSPEL OF MARK. We meet at 6:45 on Wednesday evenings in the parish center. Our leader this week while I am on retreat will be Mark Krepich, our RCIA Director. Bring your favorite bible and prepare to embark on an inspiring Lenten Journey.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS - To encourage greater participation for Stations, and to promote a greater love for the Holy Eucharist, our Friday evening devotions will begin at 5:00 with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, with Stations of the Cross beginning at 5:30. Stations will conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Please consider joining us!

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE: Remember that the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence from meat. Throughout the season of Lent, however, DAILY FASTING can strengthen our will, remind us of the hungers of the human family, and certainly can put us in mind of our hunger for God. Our fasting is closely related to our care for the poor: when I fast, another person must eat in my place!

SPIRITUAL READING - An essential part of the Christian life is prayerful reflection. This is especially so within the season of Lent. We are making available a booklet of daily meditations for use throughout the Lenten Season. Consider this Lent to be a personal retreat!
