MASS OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK – On Sunday, April 21st, at 2:00 PM, our parish will celebrate a special Mass of Anointing. Whether you are enduring physical or spiritual distress, chronic depression or melancholy, Christ extends his healing touch and embrace.

<u>WEEK 28</u> OUR SACRED STORY RETREAT: During this Easter Season, I would recommend that together with your daily Examen, you continue your daily reflections on the beautiful prayer of St. Ignatius which we have been praying at Mass each week: Take, O Lord, and receive, all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my entire will, all I have and call my own. You have given all to me. To you, O Lord, I return it. Everything is yours; do with it what you will. Give me only your love and your grace, that is enough for me. Pray this prayer slowly each day, allowing it to find its deepest roots in your heart.

The Feast of the Annunciation is usually celebrated on March 25. But when March 25 falls on Palm Sunday, during Holy Week (as it did this year), or within the octave of Easter (the week following Easter) these periods take precedence over all other feasts. Therefore, the feast of the Annunciation has been postponed to the Monday of the second week of Easter. This year, it will be celebrated on Monday, April 8.
