As His Holiness Pope Francis so beautifully expressed it: "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us, and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision." Throughout this Jubilee year, we are called to reflect on God's boundless mercy and embrace our mission to live out the Gospel in everyday life.

## A Few Words from the Pastor:

**CELEBRATING THE ARTS!** In the month of February, of this Jubilee Year 2025, the church invites us to celebrate the artistic talents of God's people, meant to reveal the beauty and goodness of God. We rejoice in the great number of folks who have offered for display their art and the contribution that they are making to building up the kingdom of God. Please take the time to enjoy and savor the art that is so evident in our talented parish community. The Jubilee of Artists and the World of Culture is set to take place in the Vatican from 15-18 February 2025. The Pope will preside over the Eucharistic celebration in St. Peter's Basilica on the 15<sup>th</sup>, and later in the day, the artists will undertake a pilgrimage through the Holy Door of the Basilica.

**CALLING ALL PALM!!** As we prepare for Ash Wednesday, anyone who would like to donate their palms from last year is invited to do so. There will be a basket in the gathering space, and the palms will be burned and used for the ashes for Ash Wednesday.

**LENT COMETH!** In just two weeks we will enter the most sacred season of Lent! Now is the time to prepare for this journey of grace by obtaining reading materials that can enrich your spiritual journey. There are three excellent resources for this Lent, all available in the Gathering Space. Again this year we will make available at no cost a wonderful booklet for daily meditations entitled **Not By Bread Alone.** If you wish to participate in a small group discussion, Mary Petrak is offering a Sunday evening study using an insightful book by Ronald Rohlheiser, **Prayer: Our Deepest Longing**. It is also available in the Gathering Space for \$10. Finally, we are offering a book for individual or group reading by Barbara Brown Taylor entitled **An Altar in the World**, in which she explores various "practices" for finding God in daily life.

**BARBARA BROWN TAYLOR** is an episcopal priest who shares how she learned to find God beyond the church walls by embracing the sacred as a natural part of everyday life. In *An Altar in the World*, Taylor shows us how to discover altars everywhere we go and in nearly everything we do as we learn to live with purpose, pay attention, slow down, and revere the world in which we live!

A WORD FROM THE VATICAN – Speaking for Pope Francis, Cardinal Michael Czerny, prefect of the Vatican's Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development, strongly condemned what it called "the reckless decision by the U.S. administration to abruptly close USAID funded programs and offices worldwide." He warned: "Stopping USAID will jeopardize essential services for hundreds of millions of people, undermine decades of progress in humanitarian and development assistance, destabilize regions that rely on this critical support, and condemn millions to dehumanizing poverty or even death."



STEWARDSHIP CORNER: Today's readings speak of an essential quality for the Christian steward – hope. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "Hope is the theological virtue by which we desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ's promises and relying not on our own strength but on the help of the grace of the Holy Spirit (CCC 1817)."

In many ways, this is the very definition of a stewardship way of life – focusing on eternity as we live our daily lives and relying on God to provide for our needs and satisfy our deepest longings for meaning and happiness right now.

In today's Gospel, Jesus describes the character of one who is living a life of hope – the life of a Christian steward whose trust is firmly rooted in God and who is focused on others and eternity. It is not always an easy life, but it is a deeply meaningful life and one that leads to eternal reward.
