FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION: This is the day on which we honor Mary's sharing in the resurrected life of Jesus, as she is assumed body and soul into heaven. This is the promise given to each of us who die believing in Him. There will be an evening Vigil Mass at 6:00 on Thursday, August 14th and an 8:30 morning Mass on the feast, Friday, August 15th. This feast is one of the four Marian dogmas of the Catholic Church and was defined as such by Pope Pius XII on 1 November 1950. The other Marian Dogmas are: Mary Mother of God, the Immaculate Conception, and Mary's Perpetual Virginity.

STEWARDSHIP CORNER: Whether you are just beginning your stewardship journey or have been living a stewardship way of life for years, today's readings invite us to ask ourselves two potentially life-changing questions. The first question is: "What do you treasure?" Of course, we all know the 'right' answer to this question – we treasure our faith, our family and our friendships. But Jesus tells us in the Gospel passage from Luke how we can discover the real answer to this question. He says, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." To bring to light what we truly treasure in life, we can ask ourselves. "Where do I spend the majority of my energy, my thoughts, my time, and my money?" The second question today's readings ask is: "What would you do if you were not afraid?" To put it another way, what would you do if you had radical faith in God? In the Gospel, Jesus tells us plainly, "Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom." If our perfect Father is pleased to offer us nothing less than His Son right now, and Heaven eventually, then what on earth have we to be afraid of? There is so much to think about this week. Let's ask ourselves what we really treasure, and then take a bold risk – faith-filled and unafraid – to show our gratitude to God for all that He has given to us.
