A Few Words from the Pastor:

FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION – On Monday we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception**, honoring Mary's unique grace of being conceived without original sin. As a **Holy Day of Obligation**, all are invited to join us for Mass as we give thanks for Mary's "yes" and God's saving work in her life. Let us come together as a parish family to honor our Blessed Mother and seek her guidance as we prepare our hearts for Christ during Advent. Masses for the Holy Day will be celebrated at 8:30 AM and 6:00 PM.

THE FEAST OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE – On Friday we celebrate the apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary who appeared to Saint Juan Diego in 1531 on Tepeyac Hill (near present-day Mexico City). She is one of the most important religious and cultural symbols in Mexico and across the Americas. According to tradition, the Virgin Mary appeared several times to Juan Diego, asking him to build a church on the site. As proof for the bishop, she caused roses to bloom in winter and left her image miraculously imprinted on Juan Diego's cloak (the tilma).

VOCATION APPEAL: This Sunday our diocese is hosting a special vocation appeal. Bishop Bartchak is asking for your financial support in funding our renewed efforts to promote vocations to the priesthood. To ensure our parishes have priests for the future, our vocation office has developed a robust plan to reach out to young men and invite them to consider the priesthood. Your support is very much appreciated!

PRAYING FOR VOCATIONS: In keeping with our diocesan vocation initiative, we will be offering after communion a special prayer for vocations to the priesthood. This prayer will serve as a weekly reminder of our need for priests to serve the needs of our diocese.

ADVENT PENANCE SERVICE, December 14th – An important element in our spiritual life is the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. A personal confession to a priest requires humility and honesty. We cannot grow spiritually without this sacrament, for it invites us to encounter our sinfulness and to experience the healing of Christ, our Divine Physician. Our parish communal Penance Service will be celebrated next Sunday, December 14th at 4:00 PM. Please join us.
